

2019 Video Audition Requirements

Reminder: Students who are interested in applying for a scholarship are required to attend a live audition in order to be considered.

Length: Your audition footage should be **no longer than 10 minutes** in length, and it should an abbreviated barre, center, pointe (if applicable), and solo work.

Content: Make sure to include all of the following:

- Minimal barre work (one side only)
- Center adagio
- Pirouette
- Petite allegro
- Grand allegro
- Pointe work (if applicable): class work or a classical variation
- Solo: The solo should highlight your unique movement quality and artistic choices. You can choose a dance style other than ballet that features your strengths and are welcome to showcase your own choreography or someone else's.

Tips and How To:

- State or list your name and information at the beginning of the video
- Save your video to a commonly used online video service such as YouTube, Vimeo, etc.
- Save your video either as public or unlisted. Private videos are not accessible to us through our system and will delay processing of your audition.
