Title: Part-Time Community Programs Coordinator (20 hours per week)

- Dance for PD® at LINES: Free class for people with Parkinson's Disease and their caretakers.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Work closely with the Community Programs Director coordinating all activities related to HeART with LINES, HeART of Market, contracted services, and Dance for PD® at LINES.
- Regular communication and coordination with Teaching Artists and Community Partners regarding all residency activities, including classes, community engagement opportunities, professional development workshops, and public performances.
- Manage and coordinate the program's overall schedule and seasonal calendar as well as contracts and community partner service agreements.
- Establish and maintain solid professional relationships with program partners.

- A background in community-based programming is highly preferred.
