### Position Summary

Alonzo King LINES Ballet | Summer Program seeks an experienced and caring individual who has proven success in the area of overseeing minors in a dormitory setting. Resident Assistants (RA's) reside at the Monroe or Kenmore Residence Clubs in San Francisco during the full length of the program: **July 11 to August 2**. RA's are responsible for providing exceptional support to the Resident Supervisor and the highest quality of care and leadership to young students. They communicate with parents, families and staff and provide support during all non-emergency and emergency situations with students residing at the dorms. RAs reports directly to the Resident Supervisor.

This position is an exciting opportunity for an experienced Resident Advisor seeking to expand their experience and share their expertise with a nationally recognized Summer Dance Program and internationally recognized organization.

## **The Ideal Candidate**

To be part of the Resident Assistant Team you must have familiarity of the day-to-day residence housing operations and the responsibilities of overseeing youth in a resident living situation. The ideal candidate enjoys and is excellent at working in a collaborative manner in a team setting and creating a positive and safe environment for youth to thrive. Coordination, scheduling and providing exceptional customer service support to families, students, faculty, supervisor and staff is crucial.

## **Key Responsibilities**

- Responsible for the health, safety and wellbeing of the LINES Summer Program housing students at the dormitory. You will be assigned 10-12 residents.
- Strong collaborative skills and ability to follow detailed directions is a must.
- Oversee that all students follow LINES Ballet and Residence Clubs policies.
- Oversee student housing schedules, curfews, and travel itineraries for program and extracurricular weekend excursions and events, in coordination with the Resident Supervisor.
- Tracking/reporting student happenings via in-person meetings and Google sheets to Resident Supervisor.
- Demonstrates sound judgment and decision-making as it relates to interacting with students, families, team and Resident Supervisor.
- Maintaining effective and appropriate relationships with students, families, staff, team, Resident Supervisor and residence club staff.
- Faces difficult situations with tenacity and sensitivity, effectively resolving issues with students, staff, and team.
- Communicates internally and externally both verbally, and in writing, in a manner that ensures clear and mutual understanding of information to staff, students, parents, team and Resident Supervisor.
- With Team, handle Front of House duties during the Summer Program Showcase as assigned.
- Demonstrates tact and diplomacy in all interactions.
- Experience with handling sensitive or confidential information.
- Enthusiastically participates in LINES Ballet Summer Program activities, Summer Program Showcase and events.
- Other Projects as assigned.

## **Qualifications**

- 1-plus years of related experience.
- Minimum age requirement - 21 years old however we prioritize those with RA experience even if younger
- Completion of CPR Certification prior to start date
- Ability to pass a background check
- Training in areas related to youth development, mental health, conflict resolution, overseeing minors and other related subjects such as team and community building, preferred

- Experience as camp counselor or chaperone is nice to have
- Dance experience preferred.
- High energy and passion for working with youth is essential

### **Physical Demands**

- Must be able to move through the physical dormitory and LINES building space, spanning 5 floors with ability to ascend/descend stairs if needed
- Requires mental acuity to be able to perform the essential functions of the role
- Must be able to lift up to 30 lbs., reach, bend, or stoop, and reach over the head.

**Reports to:** Resident Supervisor

**Compensation:** \$19.18/hour, 35-40hrs/week

**Benefits:** full room and board provided for 3 weeks, which includes two meals a day; participation in Summer Program mentorship opportunities. Open Dance classes at the Dance Center taught by LINES faculty and selected Summer Program classes as permitted with space and schedule; Discounted LINES merchandise and tickets to LINES events as available.

**Transportation Stipend:** A stipend of up to \$100 will be provided for bus transportation to and from LINES Dance Center and Residence Clubs and any Advanced Summer Program planned events.

**Application Deadline:** Open until filled; we are looking for **4-5 Resident Assistants** for the 2026 Summer Program season!
